



School Council has set the 2021 school fees at \$200, which has been consistent for the past two years.

The school fees cover all essential items that your child requires at school for the entire year as follows:

ESSENTIAL ITEMS

Personal stationery items are bought in bulk and handed to students on the first day of school. The teacher manages the distribution of stationery — you don't have to purchase any other items!

Shared Classroom items are also covered by your School fees and include materials for take home craft projects, electives and cooking ingredients.

Curriculum materials include resources above those supplied by the Department in support of our Literacy, Maths, Science, Digital Tech, Phys Ed, Art and Music programs.

Parents are urged to use the school ordering system as the goods have been chosen for their suitability and uniformity. The school ordering system is the cheapest & surest way of having ALL children commence the school with the SAME supplies. However if you wish to purchase equivalent materials from other suppliers, please collect an individualised grade stationery list from reception. The cost of Essential Items in this instance will reduce to \$165 (\$35 credit for stationery supplied).

Eligible low income families may apply for the annual Camps, Sports & Excursions Funds of \$125 per primary school student via Lynbrook PS in Term 1 2021. Further CSEF information will be distributed via Compass early next year.

Lynbrook PS provides a number of options to support parents to access the materials and services associated with their child's education.
